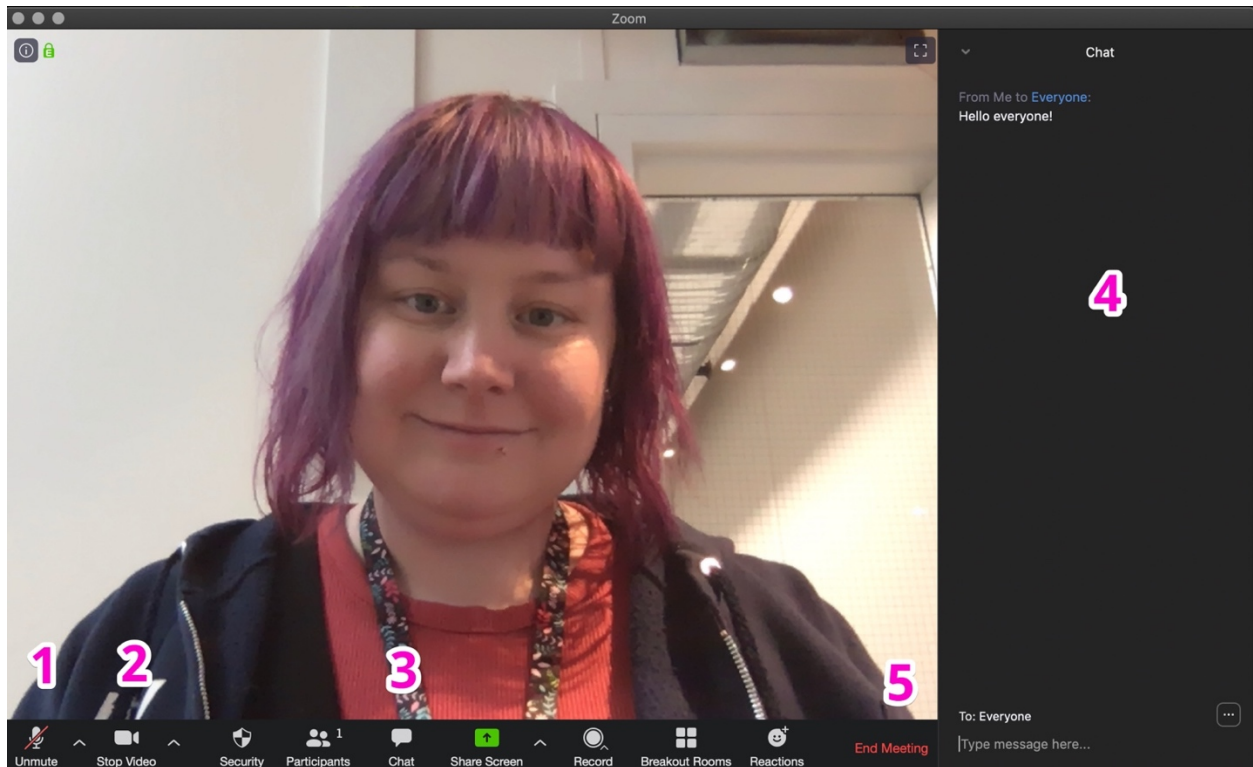


ZOOM TUTORIAL

This Zoom tutorial will help you understand the basics of participating in a Zoom meeting.



1. Mute/Unmute Sound button – red line means your child is muted and nobody can hear them speak. The teachers will often disable the function that allows students to unmute themselves during a lesson to prevent a noisy classroom.

Note: The first time your child uses Zoom, or if they're using a new device for the first time, it's a good idea to join the meeting a few minutes early so you can help them test their microphone and speakers.

2. Stop/Start Video button – students must keep their video on so teachers can interact with them.

3. Chat button – opens the chat box (#4) on the right side.

4. Chat box – all written communication will appear here

5. Leave Meeting – your child won't likely need to use this button unless they need to leave the Zoom meeting early. When the meeting is over the teacher can press a button to end the meeting for everyone.
